

Maintenance Guide

Laminate

Laminate flooring is extremely hygienic and easy to keep clean. Here are our recommendations to keep your laminate flooring looking beautiful for many years.

General Cleaning

Routine cleaning requires just vacuuming and dusting with a clean, dry cloth. A damp mop can be used to help to prevent loose dirt or grit from scratching your floor's finish. The use of 'soap-free' cleaners on a regular basis is all you need to do to keep your floor looking beautiful for many years. For more stubborn marks and long-term protective measures:

- Use a damp mop to remove footmarks and suborn dirt. Always be sure that your mop has been thoroughly wrung out - never wet mop or use excessive amounts of water on your laminate floor.
- Never use scouring substances, abrasive cleaners, paste waxes or any floor polishes on your laminate floor.
- Marks and stubborn stains can easily be removed with Acetone nail polish remover or other mild solvents containing alcohol.
- Felt pads should be affixed to the base of all furniture legs and drip trays should be placed underneath any planted pots.
- Movable furniture should be fitted with wide, rubber rollers.
- We recommend the use of non-staining walk-off protective mats at exterior entrances and in heavy traffic areas.

This is a brief guide on maintaining your laminate flooring; always refer to the manufacturer's installation guides in the packs of the flooring.
